**Accomplishments:** Senior Megan Hodge led the Nittany Lions to an unprecedented third straight NCAA National Title in 2009. She became Penn State's fourth four-time AVCA All-American and was selected as the 2009 AVCA Division I National Player of the Year. The two-time Big Ten Player of the Year and unanimous First Team All-Big Ten selection, totaled 560 kills during her final season, averaging 4.67 kills per set to lead the Big Ten and rank eighth in the nation. She closed out her career having amassed 2,142 kills to become just the second Penn State player to have surpassed the milestone. With the National Championship win against Texas, Hodge had secured a career win/loss record of 142-5. It is the best winning percentage of a Penn State graduating class and also the fewest losses. Hodge is a business management major and was named the ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-American of the Year in 2009. After being named the NCAA Regional Championship Most Outstanding Player, Hodge went on to lead the Nittany Lions in the final two matches and be named to the NCAA Championship All-Tournament team.
